Dear Friends,

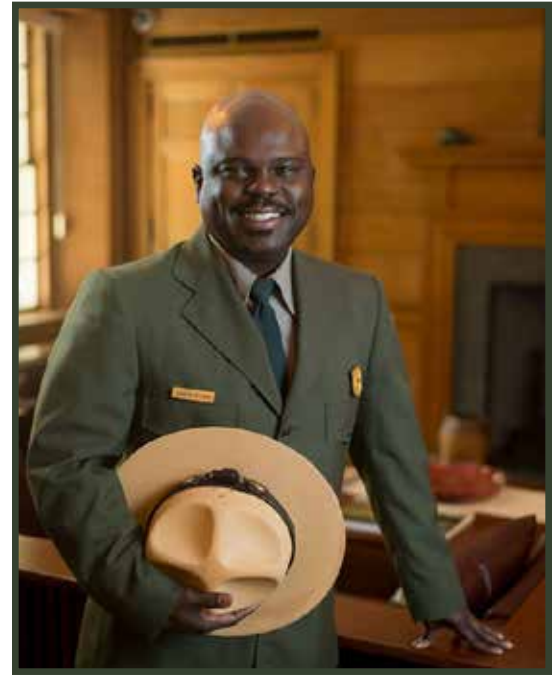

The goal of this research project, entering its fourth year, is adding the stories of African Americans to those of the early white settlers and Cherokees who lived in the area.

Virtual Field Trips

SmokiEEEs.org, built in April 2020, connects students to the Park from their homes and communities— an extension of Parks as Classrooms and in collaboration with Great Smoky Mountains Institute at Tremont, Discover Life in America, and Great Smoky Mountains Association.

Hemlock Trees Protected Annually

Friends stepped up in 2003 to help the park begin the nation's most ambitious and successful treatment programs for hemlock woolly adelgid. Approximately 30,000 hemlock trees are hand-treated by park staff annually. Hemlocks are invaluable to the Park's ecosystem and important to park campgrounds, picnic areas, and high visitation trails.

Backcountry Campsite Storage Cable Systems Maintained or Replaced

Each backcountry campsite and shelter has at least one pulley and cable system which campers are required to use to hoist their food and packs out of the reach of bears for the increased safety of both visitors and bears.

Trails Forever Milestone: Trillium Gap Trail

The two-year trail rehabilitation project on Trillium Gap Trail was completed November 2020. The 6.7-mile trail is one of the Park's most popular, leading hikers to Grotto Falls and Mt. Le Conte. Work was completed by the park's Trails Forever crew, American Conservation Experience Conservation Corps, and volunteers. Work included:

- 681** steps through steep corridors
- 224** square feet of retaining walls
- 525** linear feet of drainage ditches
- 378** linear feet of elevated trail surfaces
- 51** drainage features
- 538** native stones placed along the trail

Trail improvements have not only made them safer for visitors—but also the LeConte Lodge llamas, which use it weekly to haul supplies to the summit.

Seasonal Toilet Facilities Maintained

Funding from Friends of the Smokies covers maintenance costs for vault toilets in popular areas for visitor convenience. These facilities are located in Townsend, Roaring Fork, and Cataloochee.

Big Gift: Preventive Search & Rescue Program

Thanks to donations from so many Friends, the fully-equipped Search & Rescue truck was presented at the reopening of Trillium Gap Trail. It is being driven daily by the Park's new Emergency Manager, Liz Hall, who is building a new Preventative Search and Rescue Program.

Of the \$89,000, hikers Chris Ford and Nancy East contributed \$30,000 following a three-week fundraising hike they completed this fall traversing all 848 miles of trail within park boundaries.

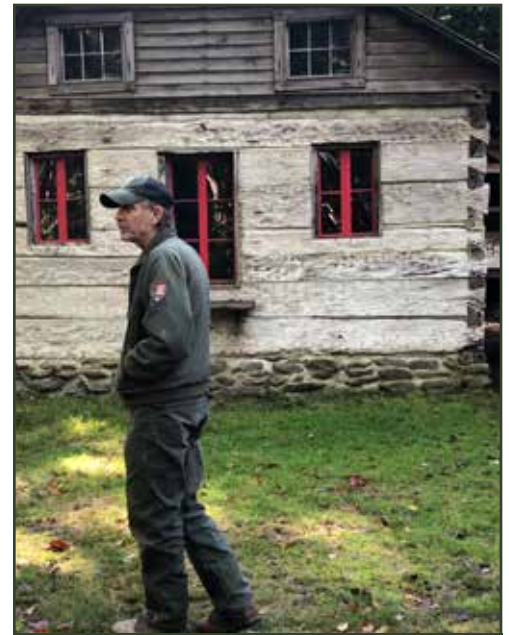

Friends of the Smokies assists the National Park Service in its mission to preserve and protect Great Smoky Mountains National Park by raising funds and public awareness, and providing volunteers for needed projects. The board of directors and staff of Friends of the Smokies sincerely thank the **Aslan Foundation of**

Knoxville, established by the late Lindsay Young, former Friend and board member, for the \$2.3 million challenge grant which created the Trails Forever Endowment in 2008.

The match was accomplished with the help of the friends and family members of **Tom Cronan and Margaret Stevenson** and many others who gave with the vision of revitalizing trails like Alum Cave, Forney Ridge, Chimney Tops, Rainbow Falls and Trillium Gap.

Kathryn McNeil was a founding board member of Friends of the Smokies. Shortly before her passing, she challenged Friends of the Smokies to match her \$600,000 gift, creating a \$1.2 million endowment to fund a full-time, year-round Parks as Classroom Resource Education Ranger position. In 2000, she and Voit Gilmore donated their mountain home and 535-acre property to Great Smoky Mountains National Park, which today is known as the Appalachian Highlands Science Learning Center at Purchase Knob. The endowment-funded ranger position serves at the Science Learning Center at Purchase Knob.

Upon **Elaine Gibson's** passing, Great Smoky Mountains National Park's leadership team learned of her bequest to help take care of our park's greatest needs. Friends received a \$2 million bequest in 2018 in order to create an endowment to help Great Smoky Mountains National Park address some of its greatest needs.

Support for Trails Forever Endures



Trillium Gap Trail reopened with a special ribbon-cutting ceremony on Nov. 10, 2020, after two years of trail restoration by the Trails Forever Crew funded by Friends of the Smokies. The 6.7-mile Trillium Gap Trail is one of the most popular trails in the park, not only used by hikers but by the llamas that transport supplies to LeConte Lodge.

The restoration involved installing 681 steps, constructing 224 square feet of retaining walls, digging 525-linear feet of drainage ditches, creating 378-linear feet of elevated trail surfaces, installing 51 drainage features, and placing more than 538 native stones along the trail.



Other Trails Forever projects completed during 2020 in addition to the signature Trillium Gap Trail rehabilitation included: Caldwell House foot log (Cataloochee), Wolf Ridge Trail foot log (Twenty Mile), Cosby Nature Trail foot log (Cosby) and Porters Creek foot log (Greenbrier).

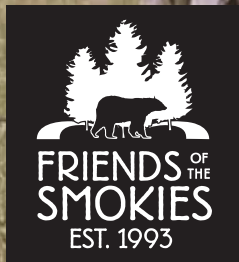
